Central Customs Laboratory given increased powers to test excisable goods produced in customs warehouses

Notice addressed to economic operators authorized as warehouse holders for excisable products

The National Customs Authority (NCA) has adopted Order no. 356 for the modification of Order no. 9250 regarding the activity of the Central Customs Laboratory and the manner in which tests are performed.

Under this Order, the Central Customs Laboratory has been given extended powers to carry out tests on a number of excisable goods which are produced in customs warehouses. Once the tests have been carried out, the NCA will then set the excises for these products, according to Title VII of the Fiscal Code. Owners of customs warehouses must obtain an authorization that the tests have been carried out before they can sell these goods.

Consequently, the possibility of varying interpretations of the level of excises applicable to certain products will be reduced. The certifications obtained can also serve as basis of comparison for goods suspected to be counterfeit.

This Order is expected to have a particularly significant effect in combating the sale of counterfeit alcoholic drinks.

This order will be published in the Official Gazette, part one.
